



## Harrisburg High School College and University Prep Program

The Harrisburg School District offers a rigorous college and university prep program for its students. Currently, three options are available to earn college and university credit during a student's high school career: Advanced Placement Courses, the Augustana University Dual Credit Program, and courses through our state's public universities. It is important that each student at Harrisburg High School take time to consider all offerings available for a given course and make the right decision for their individual circumstances. These circumstances may include the ability to transfer credits from one institution to another, course code, number of credits offered, method of assessment for passing grade determination, registration deadlines, and cost. It is the sole responsibility of the student to determine which pathway best fits their individual needs.

While we encourage all students to challenge themselves to the fullest extent, Augustana University and the College Board (Advanced Placement governing body) have created a list of suggested guidelines for students wishing to enroll in an AP or dual credit course. This list is not meant to limit those who wish to enroll, but instead to offer guidance for what it takes to be successful in a college-level course. These suggested characteristics include:

- Students with a strong academic record who are willing to put in extra hours on homework and classroom activities
- Students with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- Students who have earned a "B" or better in prior content-related courses

In addition, students interested in participating in dual credit courses through the public universities in South Dakota **must meet the enrollment requirements** found at <http://sdmylife.com/students/advanced-education-opportunities/>.

All college credits earned will be recorded with the respective academic provider (College Board, Augustana University, or Mount Marty College). It is the responsibility of the student to contact that institution and request a copy of their transcript for any and all college and university purposes. While the Harrisburg School District will record high school credits earned, it will not keep individual records of college and university credit.
